FREE THE GIRLS : EVERYDAY ABOLITIONIST

WHO WE ARE: Free the girls is a non-profit organization that provides job opportunities for survivors of sex trafficking in developing countries. We collect gently used bras, which we provide to the women in our program so they can start a small business selling them to other women.

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM? Currently 20-37 million men, women and children are being held as slaves around the world-more today than in any other time in history, the majority of those slaves are women and children. Many who are victims of sex trafficking. There are other organizations that rescue them from this but once rescued they have no means of sustaining a life with no education or income.

OUR SOLUTION? By partnering with established aftercare facilities, we provide an opportunity for sex trafficking survivors to build their own business selling second-hand clothing while going to school, building a house, and caring for their families. Selling clothes allows them to work as little as their school schedule permits. The women receive their starting inventory as a donation, and are then able to buy additional inventory from "Free The Girls" for below wholesale value to help maintain their competitive edge in the marketplace. To date we have collected over 500,000 new and gently used bras from women all over the world, and have served over 60 women in Mozambique, Uganda and El Salvador. We are currently exploring launching additional pilot programs in other parts of Africa and Central America. Please dig in the back of your dresser drawers and bring your unused bras. These ladies will appreciate it and benefit from it. Put them in the laundry basket outside the office door. And Thank YOU in ad-
